BREAST CANCERS SURVIVORS RECEIVE PERSONALIZED HEALTHCARE

Advances in the early detection and treatment of breast cancer mean that more patients than ever now survive, with 90 percent living at least five years after diagnosis and 82 percent surviving more than 10 years. The Robert H. Lurie Comprehensive Cancer Center's Breast Cancer Survivorship Program serves these patients by offering individualized post-treatment care plans and coordinating the often complicated transition from treatment to long-term survival. Philanthropy from the Lynn Sage Cancer Research Foundation helped to establish this important service for breast cancer survivors in the Chicago area.

"I had questions about the side effects I experienced due to chemotherapy and radiation. The staff at the Survivorship Program was always able to send me in the right direction to obtain the answers I needed."

Lynn Sage board member and breast cancer survivor Cindy Levy (pictured at left) received services after her treatment ended.

"There are many professionals available to help patients during the treatment phase of breast cancer," says Ms. Levy. "It's nice to know that the same professionals are available after you have finished your treatment. The Survivorship Program has helped me to be more comfortable and confident as I move forward with my life."

Patients in the Survivorship Program receive an initial evaluation, which includes a detailed history and physical exam as well as a review of their medical records. When necessary, laboratory tests are ordered to measure bone health, metabolic parameters and cardiac risk factors. As part of their individual Survivorship Care Plan, each patient receives a personalized exercise plan and can consult a Registered Dietician with oncology experience.

"The upward trend in breast cancer survival is very exciting. We now have the responsibility to help women deal with complex medical, emotional and quality of life issues that may emerge after diagnosis and treatment."

The multidisciplinary program is led by Judith Abramson, MD, (pictured at left). Herself a breast cancer survivor, Dr. Abramson is an internist, clinical researcher and Medical

Director of Cancer Survivorship at the Lurie Cancer Center. "Survivors may confront diverse health challenges," Dr. Abramson. "We tailor recommendations for cancer surveillance, encourage lifestyle changes that reduce risk of recurrence, monitor for possible side effects of treatment, and in all these ways promote wellness."

"There is a clear need for continued research on cancer survivors. If we can accurately measure the consequences of cancer diagnosis and treatment, then we can more effectively monitor and promote health and quality of life after routine treatment."

Future plans include a research initiative led by the program's psychologist, Sofia Garcia, PhD (pictured at left). Studies will include projects such as developing a computerized Specialized Care Plan module and evaluating the impact of survivorship care planning on patient outcomes. "We must develop and evaluate interventions, studying factors such as diet, exercise, coping, social support and symptom management," says Dr. Garcia. "These factors can ameliorate both the late and long-term effects of cancer treatment that many survivors suffer, and also can foster survivors' health, functioning and well-being over time."

LIGHT THE WAY TO FIND A CURE



LSCRF created the Light the Way to Find a Cure Campaign in 2002. In October 2011, 141 Chicagoland properties lit pink or flew pink ribbon flags to participate in National Breast Cancer Awareness Month. The campaign reminds women about the importance of early detection, and hopes to offer comfort and support to survivors, and all those affected by breast cancer.

Dear Friends,

I am honored and thrilled to follow in my mother's footsteps by becoming Lynn Sage Cancer Research Foundation (LSCRF) Chair. I feel responsible—as the daughter of a breast cancer survivor, as the daughter of a founding member of the LSCRF, as someone who knew Lynn and her family, and as a young woman—to take a leadership role in the fight against breast cancer. I have inherited a dynamic and successful organization, grown through the hard work, tenacity, and

fundraising prowess of so many who came before me. I look forward to carrying on their work in making a difference in the lives of women and men impacted by breast cancer.

With that in mind, I am thrilled to report the past year's success. There have been several accomplishments that are worthy of note:

- The sold-out 2012 Be My Valentine Family event at the Ritz-Carlton featured Justin Roberts as the headliner and attracted over 400 guests, raising \$38,000 in net revenue.
- Goldie Hawn was the keynote speaker at the 2011 LSCRF Fall Benefit. The luncheon sold out, raising almost \$450,000 in net revenue, with the annual purse auction, *Purse-sue the Cure*, contributing nearly \$75,000 to our total.
- The 20th Annual Golf Outing raised \$80,000 last year. On June 18, 2012 the golf outing will move to Onwentsia in Lake Forest, one of the nation's premier golf clubs.
- The *Light the Way to Find a Cure* Campaign continues its success, with 141 properties illuminating the Chicago skyline pink and displaying pink ribbon flags to remind women about the importance of early detection.

With your help in 2011, LSCRF raised over \$1 million to support innovative breast cancer research projects and important education initiatives at Northwestern Memorial Hospital and the Robert H. Lurie Comprehensive Center. In our 27 year history, LSCRF has raised \$25 million for the fight against breast cancer.

We continue to carefully consider how we distribute our funds. The Board of Directors meets frequently to strategize ways to maximize LSCRF's dollars. We are proud to announce that in 2011 only six percent of our fundraising was used for administrative support, meaning 94 percent of every dollar raised goes directly toward breast cancer research.
